LIMITS & LUNKERS

Tournament Rules

1. All Boats must have an aerated livewell system.
2. Only 5 fish (Largemouth & Smallmouth Bass) per boat/team (unless otherwise stated by the tournament director) may be kept in the livewell during the tournament and weighed in at the completion of the tournament. Once a limit of Bass has been caught (5 Bass), teams must cull (throwback) any additional fish over the 5 fish limit after making a choice of which 5 they will keep in the livewell. Any angler who catches a fish once a 5 fish limit is caught must cull (throwback) 1 fish before resuming fishing (making any cast). If that angler casts before releasing the 6th fish a 2lb penalty will be administered.
3. All fish must be over the 12 inch minimum size limit unless otherwise stated by Fish and Wildlife as in the case of Lunker Lakes. All fish must be measured on a flat ruler, closed mouth in its natural state without squeezing the tail.
4. NO LIVE BAIT
5. NO TROLLING
6. A courtesy distance of 25 yards on either side of a boat will be given to teams that anchor on a designated location. TROLLING MOTORS MUST BE PULLED OUT OF THE WATER and if you let one team in any team can come in.
7. A courtesy distance of 25 yards on either side of a boat will be given to teams that anchor on a designated location. TROLLING MOTORS MUST BE PULLED OUT OF THE WATER and if you let one team in any team can come in
8. **LATE PENALTY** - 1 lb for every minute that an entrant is late to the dock area up to a maximum of 5 minutes. After 5 minutes teams are automatically disqualified ***NO EXCEPTIONS***. If boat is removed from the water before weighing in, a tournament official must be notified and a fish count taken prior to pulling the boat out of the water.
9. 8 OZ will be deducted from a teams total weight for every dead fish. However, if the dead fish is also a lunker candidate the dead fish penalty will be applied to that fish when being considered for lunker.
10. Finish places are determined by total weight and ties will be broken in the following manner:
 - a. most fish;
 - b. largest fish;
 - c. divide the place prizes
11. Any ties for Lunker of the Day will split the Lunker purse
12. Life Jackets must be worn when outboard motors are running regardless of size and speed.
