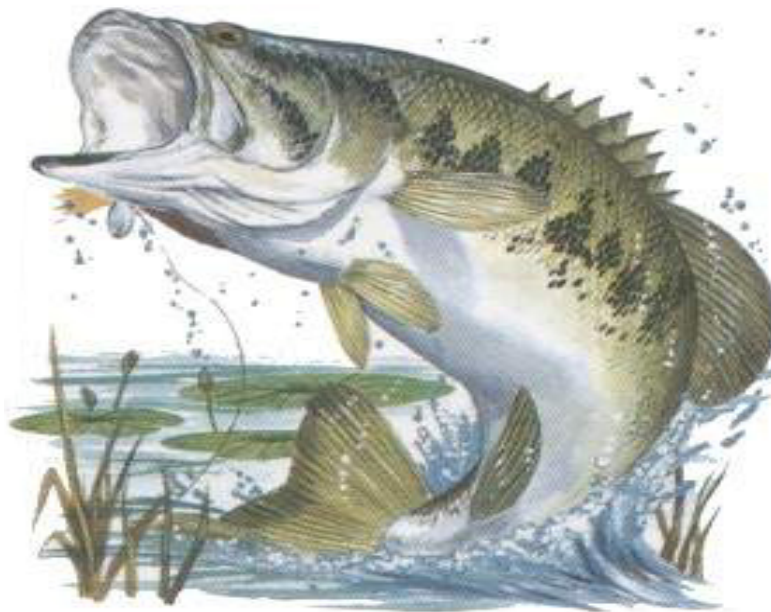

Tournament Rules & Regulations

All competitors must check-in at the registration table to obtain their boat number, and pertinent information regarding the tournament. Boat numbers will be based on random draw at time of check-in.

All competitors must comply with Federal, State, and Local fish & game regulations.

All boats must meet Federal, State, and Local safety regulations, and must have a working aerated livewell system.

5 bass limit (any combination of Largemouth/Smallmouth) per boat, minimum length of 12”.

Culling must be done immediately. No more than 5 bass may be possessed while fishing or under power.

No culling of dead fish. Dead fish may be weighed and counted with an 8oz (half pound) per dead fish penalty.

Live or prepared bait is prohibited. Pork type trailers are allowed.

Competitors may have only 1 line in the water at any given time. No trolling or fly fishing.

Landing nets are permitted.

All bass must be caught live and in a conventional sporting manner. Snagging visible fish is prohibited, and is grounds for disqualification.

All fishing and landing of fish must be done from inside the competitor's boat.

No fishing within 25 yards of an anchored boat with the front trolling motor out of the water.

Competitors must stop fishing at the end of the tournament (all lines must be out of the water) and be present at the ramp area (within 50 yards). Competitors considered late to the ramp will be disqualified.

All fish must be brought to the scale in a weigh bag filled with water, then promptly released after weigh in.

Courtesy measurements are permitted, but must be requested. Fish that measure short (without a courtesy measurement) will result in an 8oz (half pound) deduction from the total weight, and the fish will not be counted.

Winners will be determined by total weight. In the event of a tie, the place money will be evenly split between tying competitors (i.e., 2 competitors tie for first place - first and second place money will be evenly split). Lunker weight ties will evenly split lunker money.

All disputes and or protests must be filed immediately with the Tournament Committee. In all cases, the Tournament Committee's decision is final.
